30. DOMAINE JEAN-LOUIS CHAVE, HERMITAGE BLANC, RHONE VALLEY, FRANCE 2011 This is a fantastically made white Hermitage from the well established produced Jean-Louis Chave. This wine is full-bodied and richly textured, the blending of the Marsanne and Rousanne give a slight honeyed essence to the wine. It will benefit from a short period of decanting and It is an excellent match for crab, lobster and other rich fish dishes.	£162
31. DOMAINE DES VALERY, CHABLIS PREMIER CRU, FOURCHAUME, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2016 Baked bread aromas and a full flavoured palate characterise this superb Premier Cru Chablis. It is dry with an abundance of citrus and green fruits. The well positioned vineyard of Fourchaume slopes gently down the road to Maligny, home to the Durups who own Domaine des Valery.	£60
32. CHATEAU DE LAVERNETTE, POUILLY-FUISSE, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2010 This cuvée is named after the current vineyard owners ancestor, Jean-Jaques de Boissieu, an engraver and etcher from the 18th century whose drawings feature on front of the wine. This is a classic Pouilly-Fuisse with aromas of stone fruits, pears and a hint of ginger with a long crisp finish. This wine is excellent on its own as an aperitif, or paired with rich and creamy soups or seafood.	£75
33. DOMAINE TOLLOT BEAUT, CORTON CHARLEMAGNE GRAND CRU, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2012 This fantastic Grand Cru Burgundy is from one of the regions most prestigious appellations, named after the famous Emperor Charlemagne who planted the first white grapes on the Corton hillside. On the palate are the symbolic and ever sought after flavours of Corton; baked pears, figs and a slightly flinty mineral essence.	£170
34. DOMAINE ETIENNE SAUZET, 1ER CRU PULIGNY-MONTRACHET, LES PERRIERES, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2011 Domaine Etienne Sauzet, located in the village of Puligny-Montrachet is arguably one of Puligny's finest domaines. The domaine was established in the 1920s and at its height, had 12 hectares of vines. This is an incredibly pure white with very fresh and clean aromas of butter and stone fruits. It is very fresh on the palate with a crisp acidity but gently balanced by a slightly 'creamy' texture.	£132

Time spent in a decanter will reveal hints of this wines more complex flavours such as olives, anise and a subtle woodiness.	£75
63. BAROLO DOCG, RIVA DEL BRIC, PAOLO CONTERNO 2013 A fantastic Barolo that has masses of liquorice and black plum flavours and a refined smoothness from having spent 24 months in French oak barrels. Giorgio Conterno, son of Paolo, is an energetic young grower near Monforte d'Alba.	£120
64. CHATEAU BATAILLEY 5ME CRU CLASSE PAUILLAC, BORDEAUX, FRANCE 2011 This is a fantastically produced Bordeaux that is deep red in colour fresh in style, with a well defined and solid structure. The powerful nose displays a mix of ripe red fruit with toast and vanilla notes, whilst on the palate there are subtle flavours of blackcurrant and some well rounded tannins followed by a long oak finish.	£136
65. DOMAINE D'ARDHUY, VOSNE ROMANEÉ PREMIER CRU, LES CHAUMES, BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2015 An organic red from the small vineyard of Les Chaumes, only 900 bottles from this small parcel of vines are created every year. The vines date back to the 1940s making this a very sought after wine. The wine is a concentrated ruby colour with a very elegant nose featuring floral notes of peony and violets and hints of fruit.	£140

It has powerful aromas of raisins, blackberries and dark chocolate whilst on the palate is a wonderful expression of figs, with a light source and a gentle nutty finish. A top choice to partner a cheeseboard and rich chocolatey desserts.

GRAHAMS QUINTA DOS MALVEDOS, VINTAGE PORT 2004

Grahams greatest vineyard is the famed Quinta Dos Malvedos vineyard. It was acquired by Grahams in 1890 and has since been acknowledged to be one of the finest vineyards of the Duoro. This vintage reflects these acknowledgements by continuing to show its ageing potential and its excellent characteristics from a young age. To the nose are ripe plums and cassis and to the palate is a hint of blackberries figs and nuts, this port would be an excellent choice to pair with chocolates and sweet souffle puddings.

TAYLORS LATE BOTTLE VINTAGE 2012

A rich, robust and fruity port, late bottle vintage ports are aged four to five years prior to bottling. This one in particular is made from the Touriga Nacional and Tinta Roriz grape varieties, the palate is smooth and rounded with flavours of redcurrant, raspberry and blueberries.

NOVAL 10 YEAR TAWNY PORT

From Quinta Do Noval comes this finely poised tawny port full of flavours of caramelised oranges and figs. The 10 years of ageing has mellowed this wine into a perfect choice to be served chilled as an aperitif or with fudge and caramelised fruit puddings.

CHURCHILL'S WHITE PORT

A full flavoured, rich, off dry white port, with a nutty nose and aromas of raisins and dried flowers. The palate is nutty and spicy with creamy, luscious fruit and a long finish. A fine aperitif and an excellent choice with starters.

SHERRY (DRY TO SWEET)

TIO PEPE, PALOMINO FINO

Routinely praised, Tio Pepe is the benchmark in Finos having those fresh notes combined with the almondy nuttiness of Finos from the town of Jerez de la Frontera. Gonzalez Byass is still a family company.

TANNERS MEDIUM-DRY, AMONTILLADO BLEND

A mature Amontillado style with attractive nutty notes on the nose that is particularly good value. Elegant and refined on the palate, it is medium-dry without being as sweet as some others.

HARVEY'S ORIGINAL, BRISTOL CREAM,

A complex blend of some of Jerez's finest wines: delicate finos, aged amontillados, fragrant olorosos, with wine from the special Pedro Ximenez grape providing a silky, mellow smoothness.



BODEGAS HIDALGO, PEDRO XIMINEZ TRIANA

A powerful and impressive wine with luscious raisin and treacle aromas, lots of prunes and figs in the mouth rounded off with an intense, warm, roasted nut finish. Wonderful.

TORO ALBALA DON PX PEDRO XIMINEZ VINTAGE 1986

With notes of coconut, liquorice, coffee, vanilla and cinnamon. It has exceptional flavour and length, from grapes that are dried in the open air on mats to concentrate their sugar, which are then left to age for 30 years in single oak barrels.
